THESE BUS ROUTES WILL GET YOU THERE:

Routes 253 & 452 serve Maggs and travel to points south from Salisbury to Pocomoke.

Routes 253 & 432 travel north between Pocomoke & Salisbury.

IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW:

Route 253 operates Monday through Friday.

Routes 432 & 452 operate 7 days a week!

Routes 432 & 452 travel throughout the 3 Lower Eastern Shore counties. If you'd like to travel to/from Ocean City, these are the routes for you!

How To Read a Fixed Route Schedule

Look at the schedule and determine:

1. Which time point is nearest to where you want to board the bus.
2. Where is your final destination
3. The direction you will be traveling

Then:

1. Review the schedule that corresponds with time and location that you will be traveling.
2. Find your boarding location
3. Using your boarding location point as a guide, read the schedule times from left to right to find the time the bus will arrive at your starting place.
4. Once you have identified your boarding time, look down the same column to find the time that you will be arriving at your destination point.
5. Refer to the Fixed Route Bus Schedules to determine your bus route and departure times. It's best to arrive five minutes before your bus is scheduled to arrive.

Riding A Shore Transit Bus is Easy!

BUS STOP SIGNS at designated transit stops take the guesswork out of where to wait for the bus.
