



**Position Description for a Minimum-Time AmeriCorps Member
with Salisbury University's Sammy's Stash
2026-2027**

Sammy's Stash, A Secondhand Shop at Salisbury University, is seeking four students to serve as Minimum-Time AmeriCorps members for the 2026-2027 service year.

Sammy's Stash is a free resource available to all SU students and employees to shop for gently used items. It was created in response to students' essential needs and to reduce the University's environmental impact. Sammy's Stash promotes economic, environmental, and social sustainability while supporting the initiatives of inclusion, affordability, and equity to all.

Member Responsibilities:

- Run the shop during open hours (based on student availability)
- Stock and organize the shop
- Assist with the collection of donations
- Assist with the sorting of donations
- Assist with educational outreach opportunities

Requirements for applicants include the following:

- Must be a student at Salisbury University
- Must successfully pass a comprehensive Criminal History Check, which includes FBI fingerprinting
- Must be a U.S. Citizen, U.S. National, or lawful permanent resident alien
- Must be able to lift 50lbs.
- Must have a strong interest in serving the SU community and its people
- Must be able to communicate in an effective and timely manner
- Must be able to provide excellent customer service
- Must follow shop rules and procedures
- Must be able to provide a reliable work availability schedule, with availability between 9am to 5pm Monday – Friday. Shop will not be open on weekends, but some outreach opportunities on weekends occur. Plenty of notice would be given and it would be

optional.

Benefits available to the AmeriCorps Member:

- Valuable experience
- An education award of \$1,565 for future educational expenses or repayment of federal student loans - members who are age 55 or older may gift their ed. award to a child or grandchild
- Federal student loan forbearance while in service, with exemption from paying interest accrued during this time
- Access to AmeriCorps Alumni Network

The member will begin on or after August 15th, 2026 and must complete 300 hours by August 14th, 2027.
