

### **Faculty Senate Charge to the Ad Hoc Committee for Investigation of the Addition of FILM to General Education Category 3a**

This committee will review the materials submitted by the proposing department (English) and determine the suitability of including FILM as an area in the current General Education category IIIA (Humanities). By 15 February 2022, the committee will submit to the Faculty Senate President a report that provides a recommendation regarding the inclusion of FILM as an area in General Education Category IIIA. The report must include the rationale of the recommendation. In addition, when the report is discussed by the Faculty Senate, at least one committee member must attend the Faculty Senate meeting to explain and discuss the report.

If FILM is deemed suitable by the Faculty Senate for inclusion in General Education Category IIIA, then the proposed FILM 220 course and any other FILM courses proposed to be a General Education IIIA course will be reviewed for inclusion in that general education category by the Undergraduate Curriculum Committee (UCC) following the guidelines included in the UCC Curriculum Approval Guide (<https://www.salisbury.edu/administration/academic-affairs/ugrad-curriculum-committee/files/Curriculog-approval-guide.pdf>).
