 - iii. Undergrad: Thurs 9am, Seagull Stadium, Catie Griggs speaker
 - iv. Currently streamlining the program down to the minute and speeches will be a little shorter. Warmer this year, possibility of rain.
 - b. Q: What does the Orioles partnership entail? A: Marketing opportunities, advertising for SU, educational opportunities – case study, experiential learning, job shadowing, performing arts such as marching band performing, opportunities both in Salisbury and Baltimore

- b. Academic Affairs surplus funds email went out this morning – [submit ideas ASAP](#). FFOC and Deans will look through proposals
- c. Lots of new programs, certificates, and minors that have come through this year. Huge thanks to everyone's hard work
- d. Q: How is enrollment looking? A: Good, holding steady
- e. Q: Can you talk about the plan for FYS Director? A: Putting out an internal call soon based on what was recommended by GEOC, course release for academic year and summer stipend
- f. Q: What about the Dean of Honors College? A: After Provost search launches, stay tuned
- g. Q: How are we handling Workday woes after the main point person left? A: Workday Consultant will be brought in to assist, working with Workday to get a transition plan, Terri Stuck in IT has been moved to focus on Workday and help us finish out the summer
- h. Q: Folks are stressed about Workday and start of the school year – is there a plan to get HR, Admins, and IT on the same page? A: A lot of kinks worked out since this time last year, considering a designated liaison between Admin & Finance and Academic Affairs, continuing to work with Workday
- i. Q: Staff who also adjunct – making sure they won't lose IT access once adjunct contract is up? A: Shouldn't, will touch base
- j. Q: How are we doing on money returned to Academic Affairs? A: Good, larger requests coming in
- k. Q: What's the pool and is it separate from dean's money? A: 450-500K remaining, separate from what the deans have been given to work with, coordinating with deans to make sure we're not duplicating efforts, needs to be expended this fiscal year and can't be labor, send your big suggestions
