

Undergraduate Curriculum Committee Annual Report 2017-2018

During the 2017-18 academic year, the committee met six times in Fall 2017 and seven times in Spring 2018. Our meetings were held in the President's Conference Room in Holloway Hall on Thursday, except for the last meeting (May 16 2018) which was at 9 a.m. in Henson Hall. Each meeting lasted between thirty and ninety minutes. During those meetings, we reviewed, reconsidered, and approved the following curriculum proposals:

16 new courses,

1 new certificate programme,

9 changes to minors,

2 new minors,

98 course changes,

8 track changes, and

23 plan changes.

One new minor in linguistics remains tabled at the end of the academic year. The UCC is awaiting a response from English pertaining to similarities between the new minor and an existing ESOL minor.
