### About the Program

**M.Ed. Curriculum and Instruction Program:** Designed for currently certified P-12 teachers seeking advanced preparation and advancement. Students will select coursework based on your own professional goals. Core classes include study in technology, learning, diversity and educational research.

**Reading Specialist and Educational Leadership:** Programs are designed for current educators who wish to add advanced certification. The Educational Leadership Program prepares educational leaders and school administrators.

**M.S. in Mathematics Education and M.A. in TESOL:** Provide intensive content area preparation for educators. The MA TESOL program also leads to Maryland P-12 TESOL certification.

**Higher Education Leadership:** Designed for both early-career and established higher education leaders in student services, residence life, admissions, athletics and related fields. Specialty courses include college student development, higher education law and internships in higher education settings.

**Master of Arts in Teaching:** For professionals already holding a



content area degree who want to be teachers, the Master of Arts in Teaching program leads to secondary or P-12 education certification in as little as 18 months.

**Ed.D. Literacy Program:** For advanced education professionals at any level who already hold a master's degree, the Ed.D. Literacy Program provides advanced study in contemporary curriculum related to literacy. Professionals from both P-12 and college levels can pursue their doctorate in this program.
