### Who does a Post-Master Certificate (PMC) in Higher Education Leadership?

- Current higher education faculty and administration professionals who hold master degrees or terminal degrees in other content areas but have never taken any graduate classes in higher education
- K-12 teachers with a graduate degree in another discipline evolving their career to include more teaching and consulting in the higher education sector
- Other career professionals with advanced degrees trying to transition into a career in higher education

### What are some of the classes that I can take as part of the PMC in Higher Education Leadership?

Students design their certificate with an advisor based on their interests. Some of the popular courses include

- Higher Education Management
- College Student Development Theory
- History of American Higher Education
- And More

### Pathway to Doctorate in Public Administration (D.P.A.)

If you are thinking about earning a terminal degree, three courses (9 credits) from the PMC in Higher Education Leadership can be applied to the Doctorate in Public Administration (D.P.A.) at the University of Baltimore as a specialization in higher education.



### How does the PMC in Higher Education Leadership work?

- Four-course (12 credits) certificate with options to choose courses of interest to each student
- Options for all online and remote classes
- Evening classes
- Options for summer classes
- Certificate can be completed part-time in 16 months taking one course at a time
- All credits apply to the full M.Ed. in Curriculum and Instruction - Higher Education Leadership Track Program for students who want to continue their studies
- Employees at USM institutions, K-12 public school systems, and other educational organizations may be able to apply tuition benefits to the cost of tuition
