### About the Secondary/PreK-12 Education Programs

The Secondary/PreK-12 Education Programs prepare students for initial teaching certification. In Maryland, secondary certification covers grades 7-12. Salisbury University offers bachelor's degree programs leading to secondary teacher certification in the following areas:

- Biology
- Chemistry
- Earth Science
- English
- History
- Mathematics
- Physics

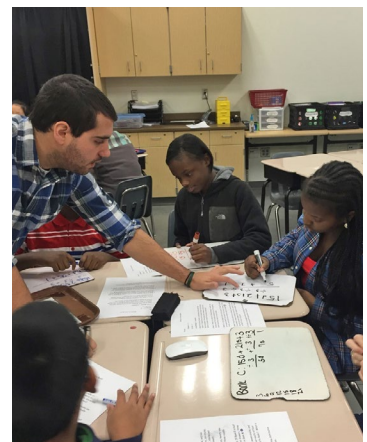
