DRC Testing Center-IMPORTANT CHANGES

In alignment with University messaging, we are **cancelling** all DRC proctored in-person exams. Students who wish to use their extended time and/or breaks accommodation(s) **MUST** do the following: (1) communicate with your faculty about your intention to use your accommodation at least **one (1) week before** each test, exam, or quiz; (2) complete the online test request form (link below) at least **three (3) business before** each test, exam, or quiz.
