Training Modules

The Roots:

1.5-Hour Training Module

- Designed for high school transition staff, prospective students, families and guardians.
- Topics include self-advocacy, the role of parents/guardians, and the differences between high school and college accommodations (IDEA vs. ADA).

The Leaves:

2-Hour Training Module

- Designed for staff, student advocates and campus leaders.
- Perfect for classroom presentations and professional development.
- Topics include ableism, inclusive language, disability rights, intersectionality, non-disabled privilege and more!

The Branches:

2-Hour Training Module

- Designed for new faculty and experienced faculty.
- Perfect for new faculty orientation and faculty professional development.
- Topics include inclusive pedagogy, universal design for learning, implementing accommodations, legal mandates, and assistive technology.
