Dear Student,

I hope this e-mail finds you well. Below you will find our guidelines for fall 2020 Returning Student Sign-Up.

**Category A:** Current on-campus students who will have completed 1-5 semesters in main campus housing at the end of spring 2020 semester will be placed in the following residence halls: Chesapeake Hall, Dogwood Village, Sea Gull Square or University Park. (St. Martin Hall may be used if not completely filled by incoming freshmen).

- Main Campus: Must complete a housing contract through GullNet December 1-20, 2019. *Application instructions will be sent before December 1<sup>st</sup>.*
- University Park: Must complete a UP application December 1-7, 2019.

**Category B:** Current on-campus students who will have completed 6 or more semesters in main campus housing at the end of spring 2020 semester are NOT eligible to return to Main Campus Housing.

- Rising seniors desiring to reside in University Park may complete a UP application December 1-7, 2019.
- The following are the Off-Campus Housing Fairs held in the Wicomico Room of the Guerrieri Student Union before the end of this semester:
  - Wednesday, November 13<sup>th</sup>, 11am-2pm
  - Tuesday, December 3<sup>rd</sup>, 11am-2pm

**Exceptions:**

- Category B students may submit an appeal to remain in Main Campus Housing (CP, DV or SG) if:
  - You have an approved accommodation by the Disability Resource Center.
  - You will graduate in December 2020.
  - A condition of your financial aid requires you to live on main campus.
- Please submit a detailed letter outlining your circumstances via e-mail to [house@salisbury.edu](mailto:house@salisbury.edu) no later than November 15<sup>th</sup>. Decisions will be made regarding your status by November 30<sup>th</sup>, via your SU e-mail account.
- Note: The above-mentioned factors will be verified by corresponding offices on campus.

*Keep in mind: freshmen students who enrolled for the fall semester are required to live on campus for four semesters and students beginning in the spring live on campus for three semesters.*

We look forward working with each of you through this transition and are available in the Sea Gull Square Housing Office should you have further questions.
