On-campus housing for Winter Term is NOT guaranteed. Your completion of this form will place you on a Waiting List by date received. Spaces will be assigned as vacancies are created by students leaving SU for spring. Notification of a confirmed space will be made as space becomes available or by December 1, 2019. **Applications will not accepted after December 1, 2019.**

**Winter Athletes do not need to complete this form (Basketball/Swimming), as your accommodations have been made.*

1. On-campus housing for current ON-CAMPUS residents: Wednesday, January 1, 2020 through Thursday, January 23, 2020. *On-campus residents will be required to move their permanent rooms on this Sunday, January 19 between 1-3pm and may remain there through the start of the spring semester.*
 - a. Room Rate: \$25/night - Double room, \$575.00 [23 nights (Jan 1-23); even if you move in after January 1]. Students working on campus are eligible for a reduced rate of \$15/night - \$345 (must provide copy of Work Experience Contract).
2. Students will be housed in Choptank Hall. You will receive your room assignment when you check in and get your card programmed for building access. Check-in is from 10am-4pm or 8pm-midnight on Tuesday, January 1, 2020 (the day before classes), in the Choptank Hall lobby. If you cannot check in between those times, you need to notify the Choptank Hall Area Director (Lorenzo Sanders) at 410-546-2483 in advance. We are unable to accommodate check-ins early than January 1.
3. Please note that you may be occupying a ½ open space. You are not permitted to move the furniture in the room or touch the belongings left behind by the remaining student.
4. Prior to check-in your student account will be billed. After filling out this form, if you decide that you will not be attending the winter term or that you do not need on-campus housing, please notify us as soon as possible so we can update your financial account and give your space to another student.
5. The Commons Dining Hall is only open for lunch, Monday-Friday during the Winter Term. In addition, there are meal carts in the academic buildings. Please consult Dining Services if you have further questions. A small kitchenette is available on the first floor of Choptank Hall. Microfridges are not available for rent during the Winter Term, if you do not already have one.
