In order for our office to consider a renewal of your Dependency Override you will need to provide, on a separate sheet of paper, a detailed and signed statement specifically explaining your current situation. If you are receiving financial or in-kind support from friends or relatives you must describe the amount of financial support/in-kind support and how you came to receive it.
3. Submit your 2018-19 FAFSA online at fafsa.ed.gov
 - When submitting your FAFSA online, you will probably answer “**NO**” to all the questions in the “**Dependency Determination**” section. Then on the “**Special Circumstance**” section, indicate that you are “**unable to provide parent information.**” Do not provide any parent data and “**acknowledge that your FAFSA will be submitted without calculating an EFC.**”
 - **Submit your FAFSA as early as October 1, 2017.** Please note that some aid funds will be awarded on a first come-first served basis.
MHEC Priority Deadline -Submit your FAFSA before 3/1/2018 (In-State/MD Residents only)

You must meet these deadlines to apply for additional aid from SU and from the Maryland Higher Education Commission (MHEC). If you miss these deadlines, apply as soon as possible after the deadline. You can still apply for Federal grants and loans.
4. If we approve your renewal request, we will update your FAFSA status to Independent.
