In order for our office to consider a renewal of your Unaccompanied Homeless Youth status you will need to provide, on a separate sheet of paper, a detailed and signed statement regarding your status as an unaccompanied homeless youth. Please include an update on the status of the relationship with your biological parents, your current living arrangements, employment status, sources of monetary support and your ability to be self-supportive.

3. Submit your 2018-19 FAFSA online at fafsa.ed.gov
- SU Priority Deadline - Submit your FAFSA by 3/1/2018, however some aid funds will be awarded on a first come-first served basis.
 - MHEC Priority Deadline - Submit your FAFSA by 3/1/2018 (In-State/MD Residents only)

You must meet these deadlines to apply for additional aid from SU and from the Maryland Higher Education Commission (MHEC). If your tax data is not ready by these deadlines, submit your FAFSA by these deadlines with estimated tax data. If you miss these deadlines, apply as soon as possible after the deadline. You can still apply for Federal grants and loans.

4. You may be assigned additional verification items required for your FAFSA. Any additional items needed will be assigned to your "To Do List" on GullNet and we will communicate via email as a reminder.
