Requirements for Admission to the Music Program of the
Department of Music, Theatre and Dance

To help you make tomorrow yours at SU, we share with you the process you need to follow to gain acceptance into the Music Program.

All students majoring in music at Salisbury University must successfully pass a performance audition and complete the Theory Advisory Exam. **Audition materials may be submitted online at** <https://app.getacceptd.com/salisbury>.

After submission, you will be scheduled for a follow-up interview with a faculty panel.

While some students may gain acceptance into the **Music Program** as a result of an immediate successful audition, other students may be placed in the provisional **Pre-Music Program**. Pre-Music Program students will be enrolled in Applied Study (MUSA 390) to prepare for a re-audition sometime during the first year of study at Salisbury University.

It is strongly encouraged that all admitted students submit audition materials as soon as possible, as beginning in a pre-music status may result in the need for summer/winter courses or an extra semester before graduating. Early auditions can also qualify admitted students for certain music-specific scholarships.

You are well on your way to setting success in motion with our Music Program, which is fully accredited by the National Association of Schools of Music. We offer tracks in general music, instrumental performance, vocal performance, music education, and music technology. We also offer minors in general music and music production. In addition, our music ensembles are open to all SU students, regardless of major.
