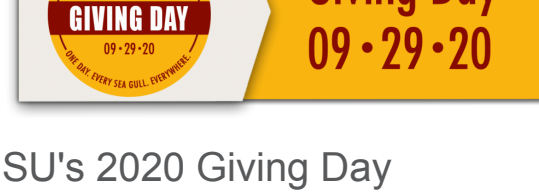


### Colin Gimblet

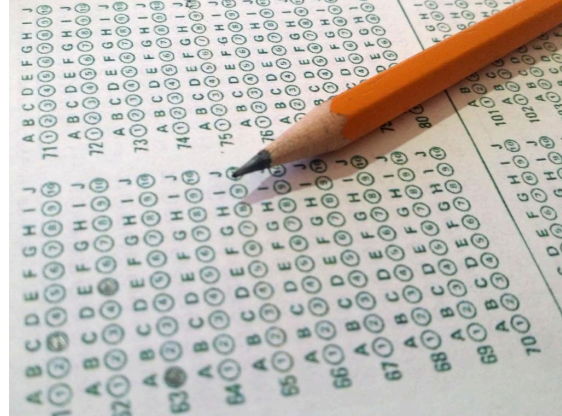

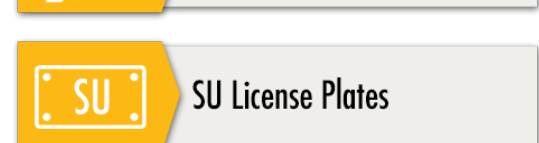

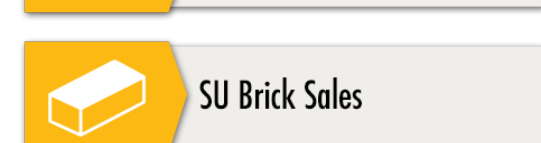
