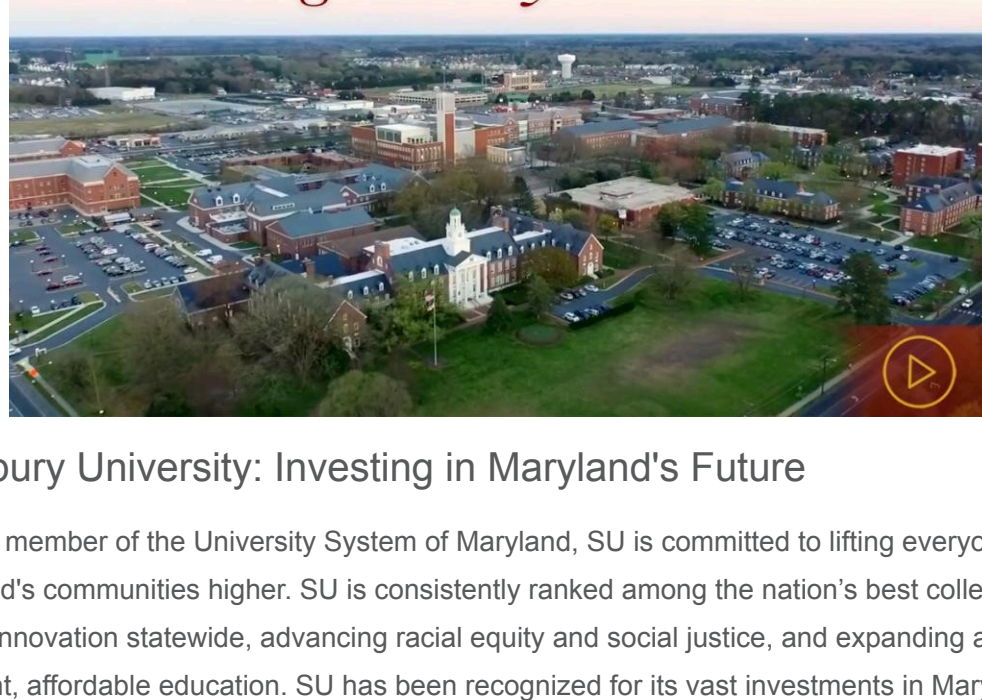
How to Talk When It's Hard to Talk
