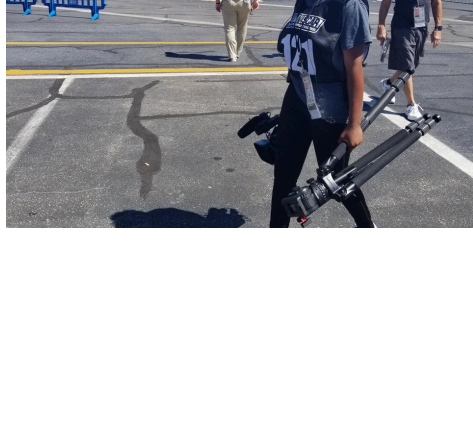

Glen Charlton

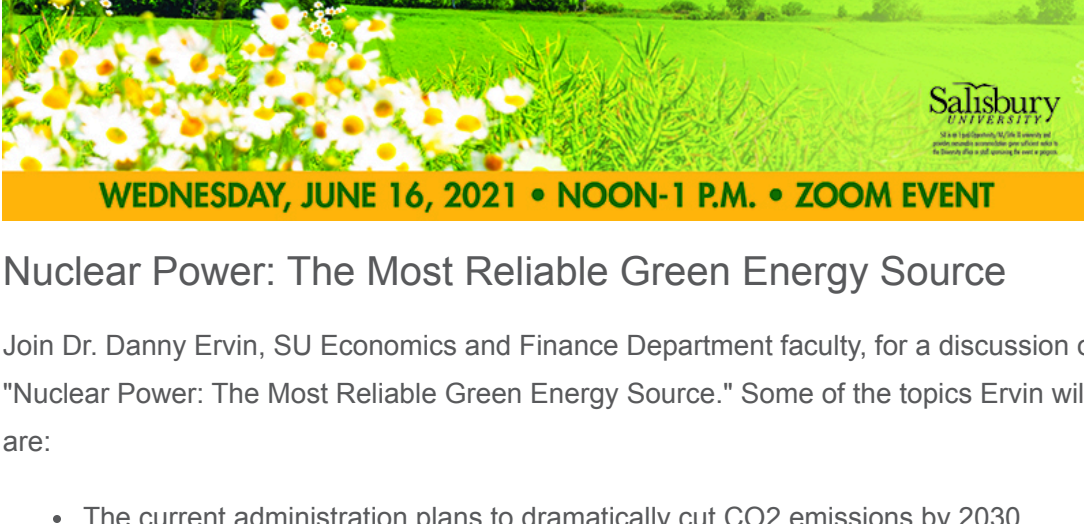

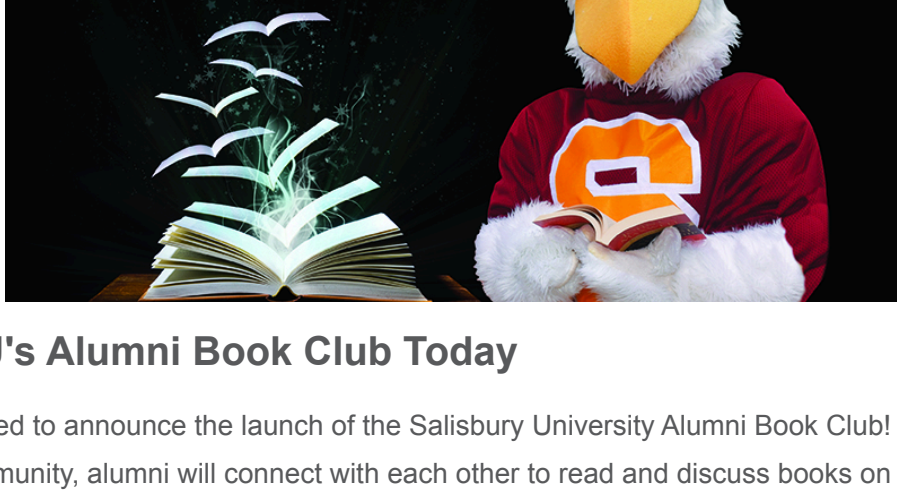


Alumni Homecoming and Family Weekend

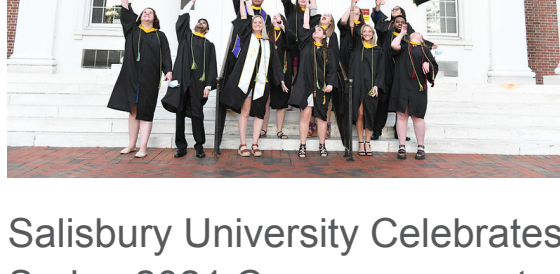

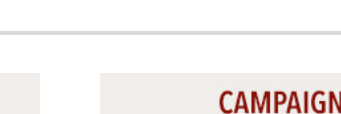
