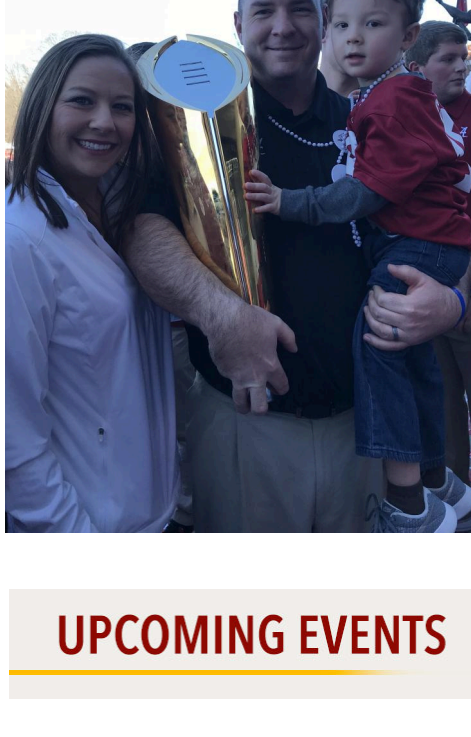

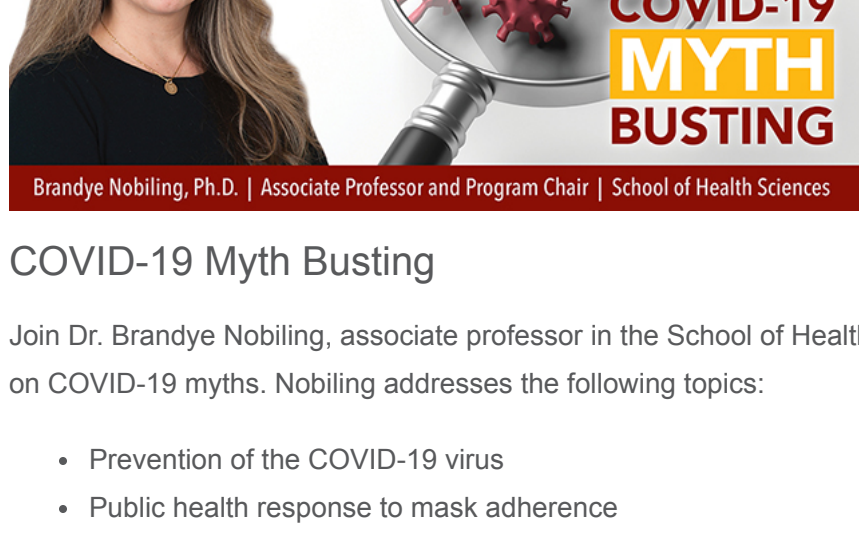


Jeremy Gsell

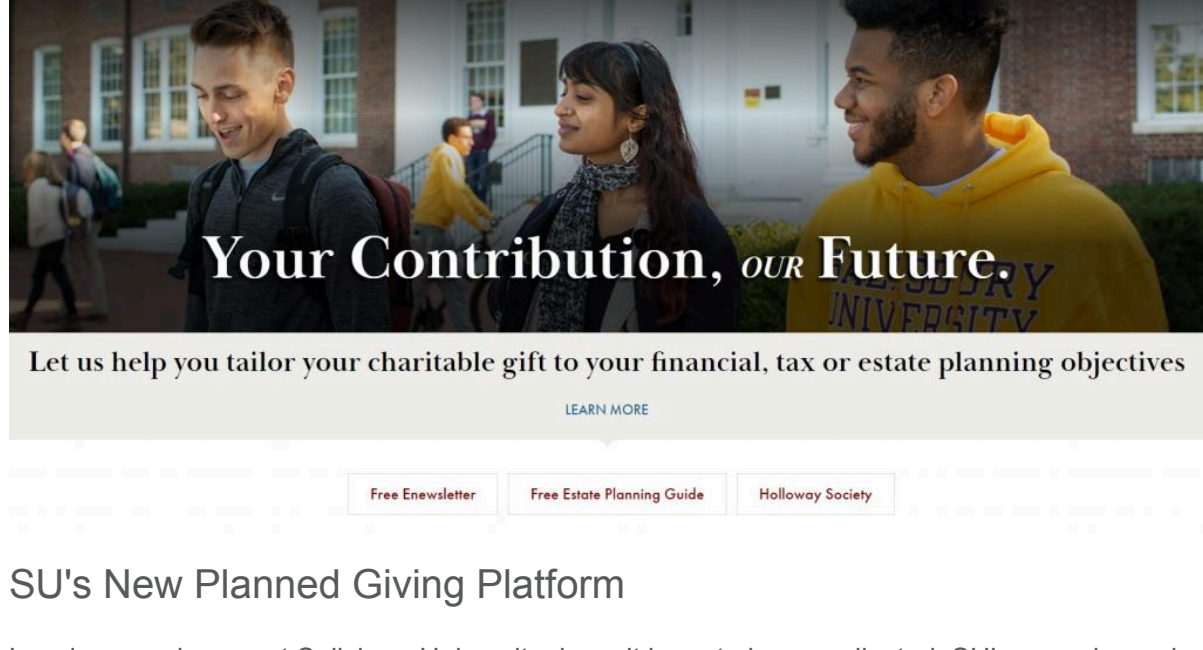


Join us for SU's Giving Day

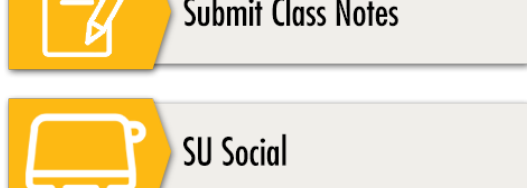
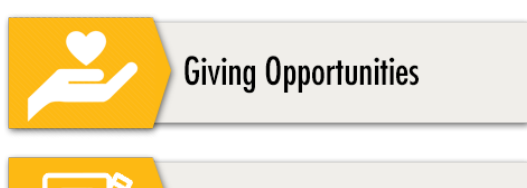
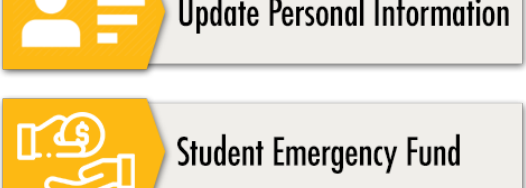
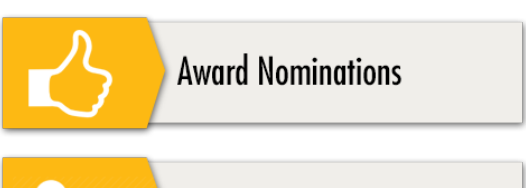


Whiteheads' \$10,000 Gift Grows Scholarship for SU Students

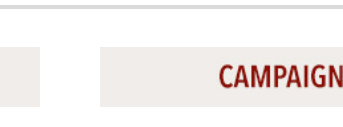
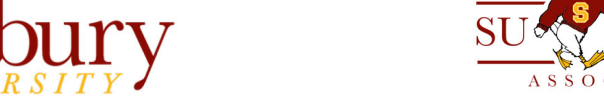
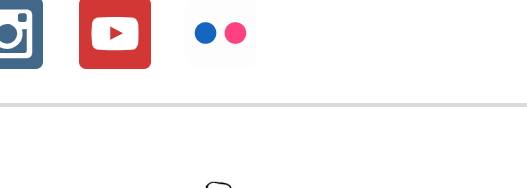
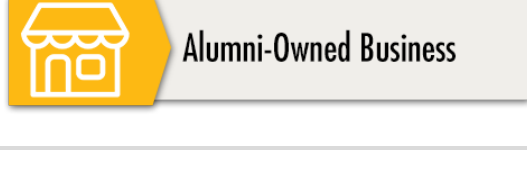
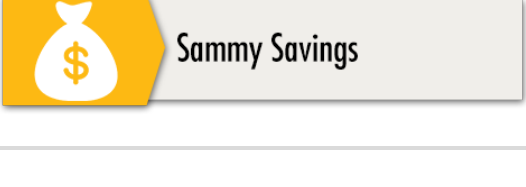
