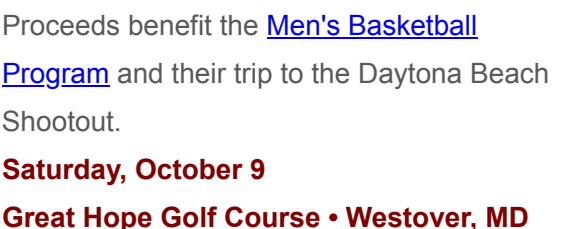


Matt (AKA "Bert") Bertone '01

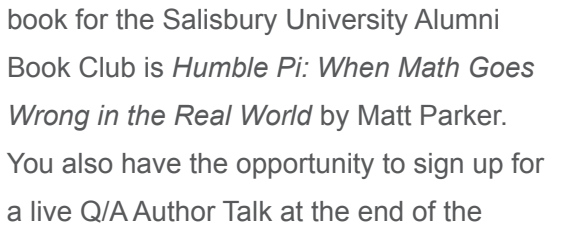

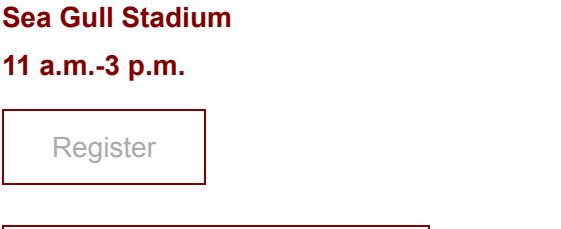
Alumni Homecoming and Family Weekend

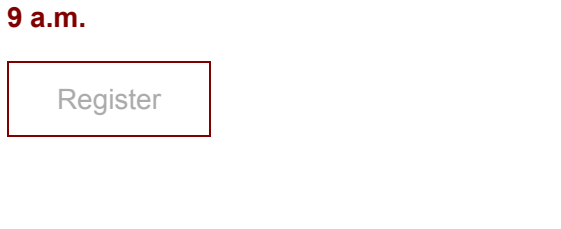

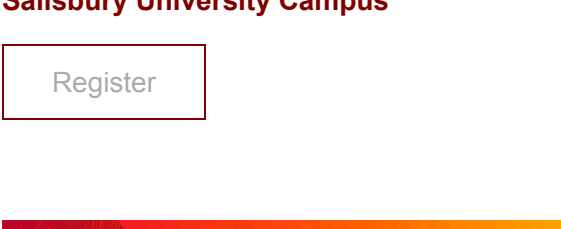

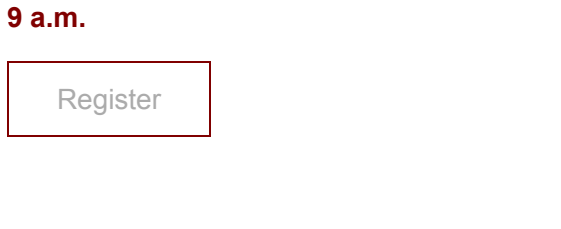
Scavenger Hunt
