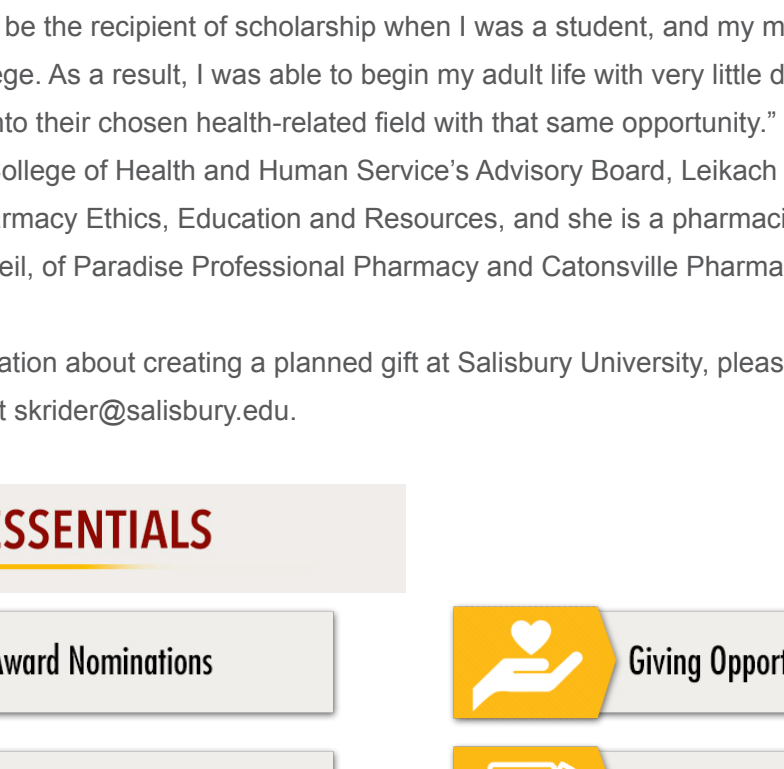


Join Salisbury University Alumni Book Club
