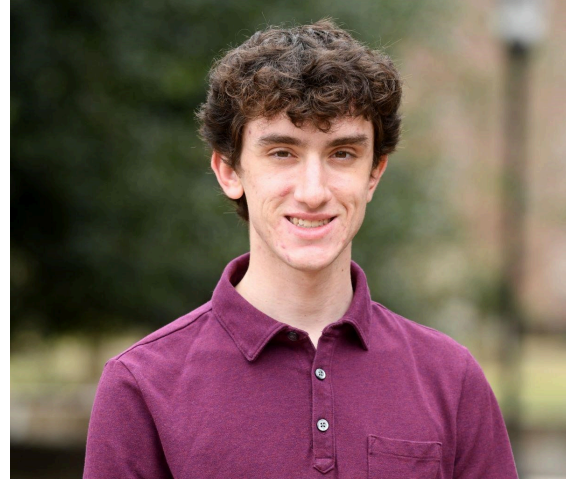

As a bastion of reading and writing tutoring, SU's May Literacy Center has helped more than 1,000 local children in kindergarten through eighth grade.

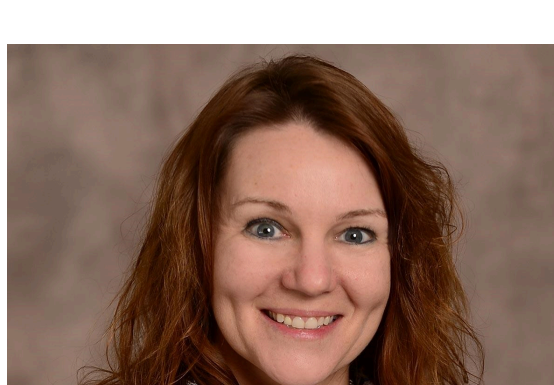
