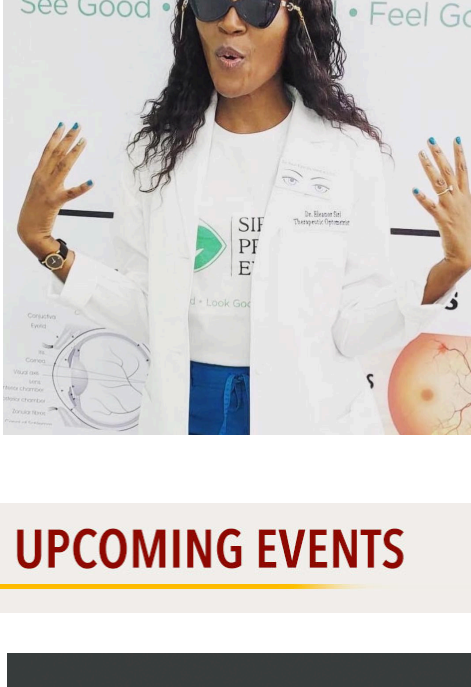

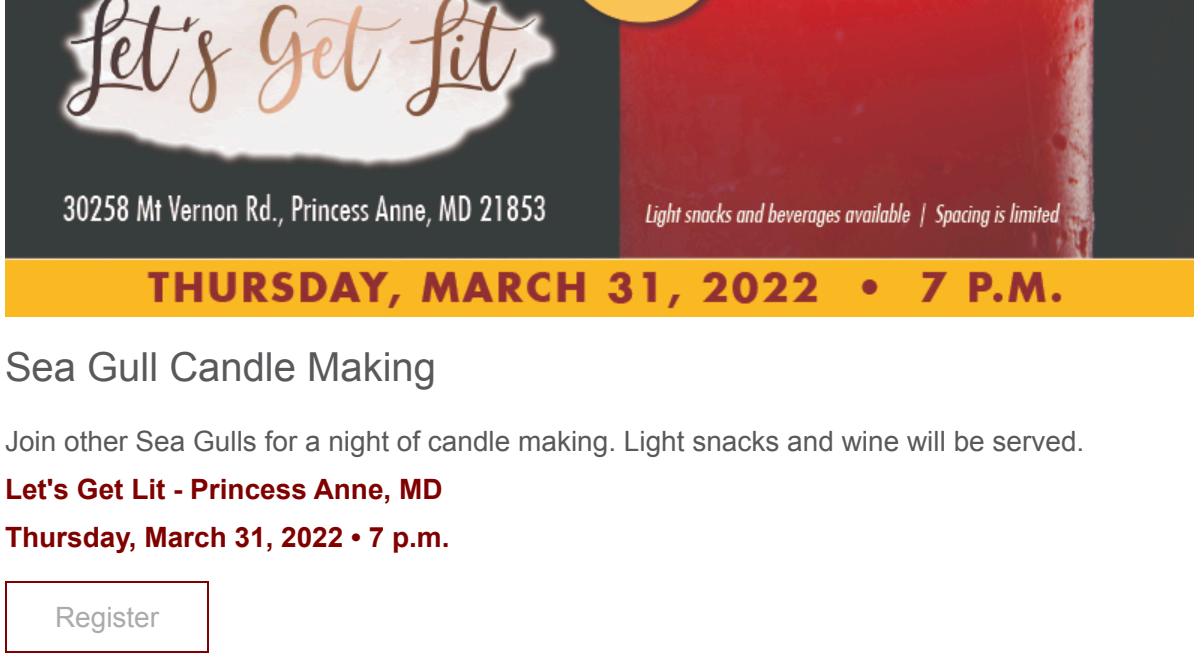


### Eleanor Siri

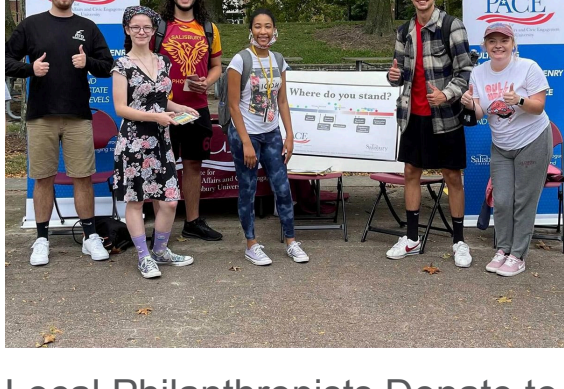

### \$3.3 Million Gift Announced for SU Scholarships

A proud 1960 graduate of the Georgia Institute of Technology (Georgia Tech), George E. Miles understood the value of higher education. Now, his legacy will live on through students on the Lower Eastern Shore, thanks to recent gifts from his estate to local colleges and universities, including approximately \$3.3 million each for Salisbury University and the University of Maryland Eastern Shore, and \$2.32 million for Wor-Wic Community College. 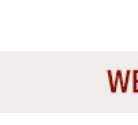

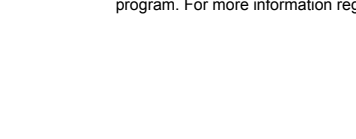
