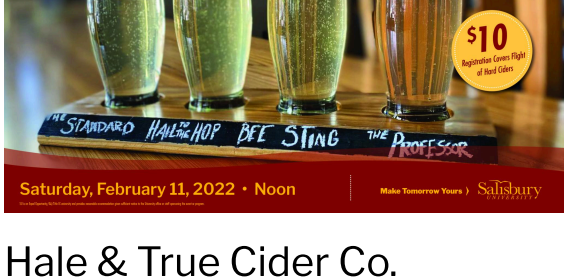


Rosa (Lauren) Marino

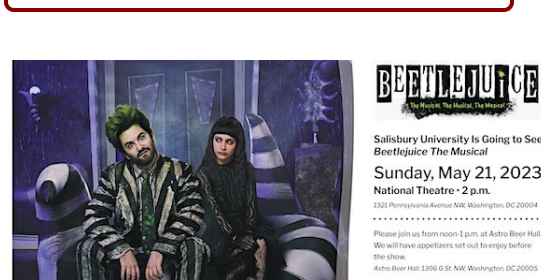

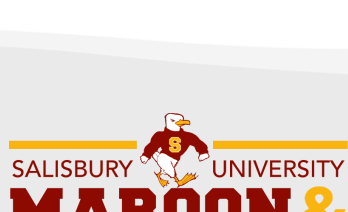
