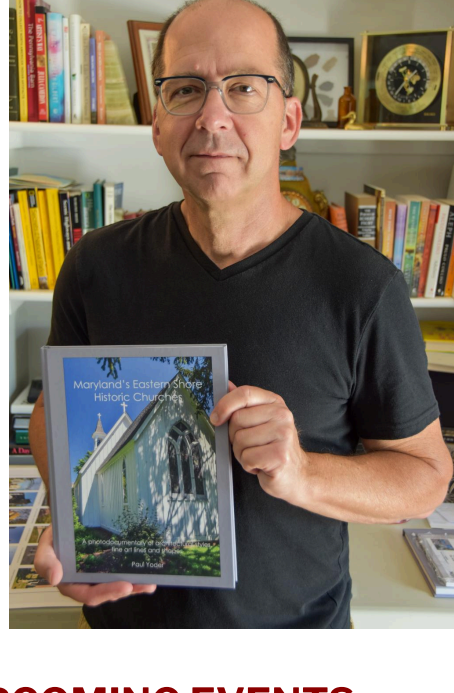

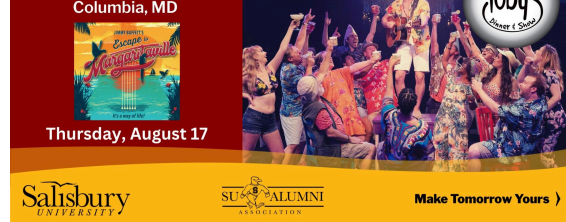


### Paul Yoder

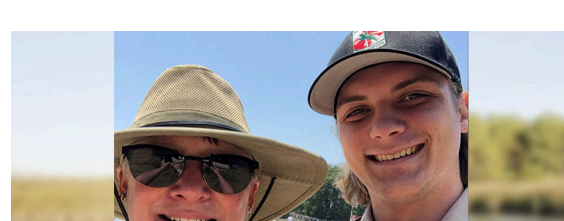

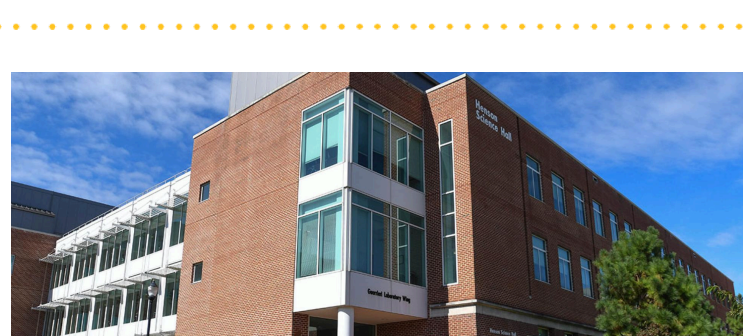

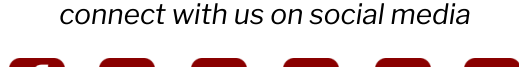
