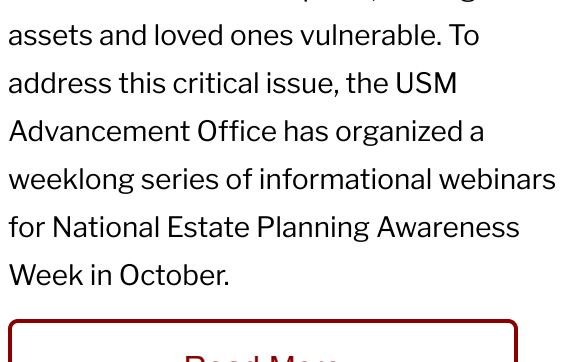


SU's Martino Named National Collegiate Honors Council Fellow

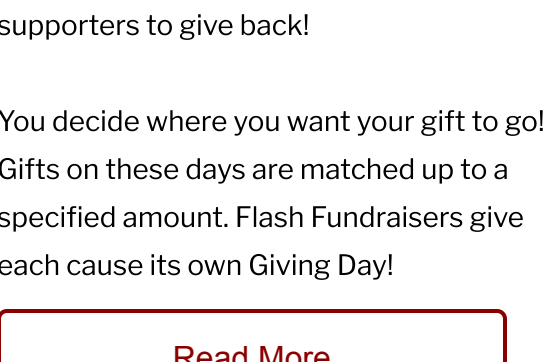

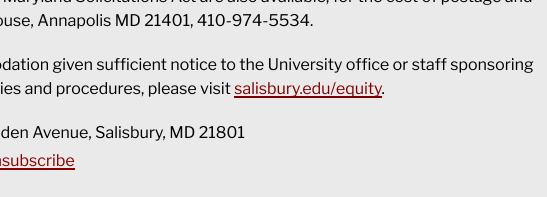
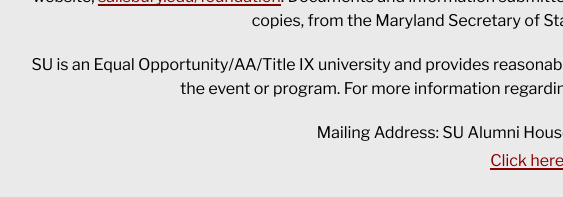
